How to Get Tickets and Plan Your Trip





FIFA opened ticket sales on September 10, 2025, using a lottery-based system.

For the first time ever, the tournament will be hosted across three countries – a unique blend of sport, culture, and travel.

The 2026 FIFA World Cup will be unlike any previous edition:

- The largest in history.
- 48 national teams.
- 104 matches.
- 3 host nations – United States, Mexico & Canada transforming North America into a massive celebration of football.

Before imagining stadium chants, selfies in Times Square, or a mezcal toast after a match at Estadio Azteca, one big question comes up...

How to get the tickets and plan the trip?



Let the adventure begins

The tournament kicks off on **June 11, 2026**, at the iconic Estadio Azteca in Mexico City – a true football temple.

With capacity for more than

80.000
spectators.

The best team will lift the trophy.

After more than a month of competition, the grand final will take place on July 19, 2026, at MetLife Stadium in New Jersey, only minutes away from Manhattan by train.

How to get the tickets?



Official sales began on **September 10, 2025**, via the FIFA Ticketing website.

Sales phases

Phase 1

(September 2025)

Exclusive access for Visa cardholders. Pre-registration required. Tickets allocated through a random draw.

Phase 2

(October 2025 –
March 2026)

The lottery continues open to the general public.

Phase 3

(April 2026)

First-come, first-served sales.

Official resale platform: Launching closer to the tournament, allowing fans to buy or resell verified tickets at face value.





FIFA also offers Hospitality Packages through On Location, featuring premium seating, catering, and lounge access.

Options include:

- Per Match
- Venue Series (per city)
- Follow My Team (per national team)

Prices start in the thousands of dollars.

Important information

Each ticket grants access to one match, unless included in a special package. **The 2026 World Cup will feature 16 host cities: 11 in the U.S., 3 in Mexico and 2 in Canada.**

How to choose
where to stay.





MÉXICO

- **México City:** Condesa and Roma are the top choices – safe, central, great food.
- **Guadalajara & Monterrey:** boutique hotels, easy air connections.



UNITED STATES

- **Nueva York/Nueva Jersey:** Many fans will stay in Manhattan with direct train access to MetLife Stadium.
- **Los Angeles:** Santa Monica (beach vibe) vs. Downtown (nightlife).
- **Dallas & Houston:** Modern stadiums and convenient flights between nearby cities.



CANADÁ

- **Toronto:** ideally stay near Union Station.
- **Vancouver:** BC Place is downtown, surrounded by parks and boutique hotels.

How to move between matches?



Given the long distances, flying will be the main way of transportation.

However, some regional clusters make travel easier:

East Coast: Low-cost airlines offer direct routes between venues.

México: Domestic flights and buses easily connect México City, Guadalajara, and Monterrey.

Canadá & U.S.: Multiple low-cost options between host cities.

International visitors must review visa requirements and electronic travel authorizations: (ETA for Canadá and Visa for the United States and México) Always allow extra days to avoid unexpected delays.

What's included in your ticket?





**A standard ticket grants entry to one match.
The real experience lies on host cities, fan festivals,
and cultural exchange.**

Hospitality packages, however, provide a premium experience — though flights and accommodation are booked separately.
